SIG Meeting update:	
<p>Since the last SCIN meeting the CT SIG has not regrouped, however as discussed in the last update we are looking at innovative ways to communicate and share. With that Lynsey Hannah our CT SIG secretary is in the process of setting up a Microsoft Teams shared space. We would encourage all members to review regularly, share thoughts, questions, experience and key documents. The committee hopes this will allow more effective and consistent engagement through the year and ensure the currency of information and enable timely change within the clinical departments. In addition it is hoped this will relieve some of the current pressure within departments contributed to amongst other things COVID recovery.</p> <p>The committee are incredibly aware of staff wellbeing, this was brought to us as a concern by a member, we aim to be mindful of this, but would hope to be able to pick up on existing projects, such as weight vs BMI based approach to iodinated contrast administration, standardisation of CT protocols and explore the impact of major trauma centre status on our CT services. Any other ideas would be greatly appreciated.</p> <p>The CT SIG have successfully completed an update on GP open access for CT for chest/ abdo/ pelvis for patients with unidentified suspected malignancy. The results have been passed to SCIN for evaluation.</p> <p>To coincide with the new vice chair Zoe Campton coming onboard the committee met separately and discussed a forward plan. We will aim to arrange a larger meeting in late spring/early summer with the possibility of a CPD opportunity attached. Moving forward the committee proposes Bi-Annual meetings with the use of a shared space as discussed. In addition, the current committee has been in place through the pandemic for 3 years, at the end of this year we will potentially be looking to recruit new members into some of the key roles.
