Often there is no particular expertise in dealing with this patient group</p> <p>The paediatric SIG will provide a pivotal role in supporting radiographers who have little specialist expertise in paediatric imaging and driving standards</p> <p>The paediatric SIG will also afford an opportunity for Support and Supervision (AHP position paper) for specialists in paediatric imaging</p>
